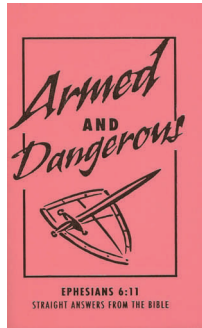

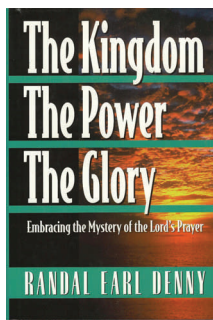

Ministering to the adults will be **Kernaa & Jean Williams, Nickie Pinson, Geri McGhee, Carla Butaud** and others.

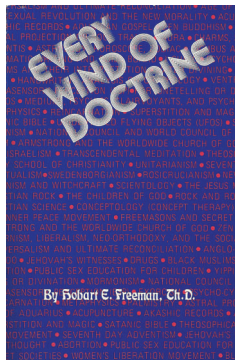

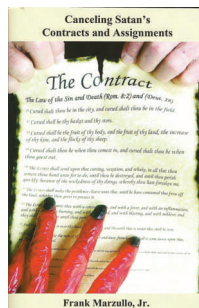

KEVIN'S KORNER

BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU THINK!

Many years ago I put together a Bible Study on thoughts. I didn't start out to study on thoughts. My intent was to study the word deceit. Patti and I were working together to lose weight. We were allowed an ice cream bar that day - which we had already eaten. She had to go to town and while she was gone, I wanted another ice cream bar. After eating my tasty treat, I proceeded to carefully hide the wrapper in the trash can - buried under other trash - so she wouldn't see it. I hadn't done anything wrong. It was just an ice cream bar. We were counting calories and I could have just added that additional amount. But what the Lord convicted my heart about was being deceitful about it. I was being "sneaky".

The word, deceitful, launched me into a wonderful study on thoughts. I don't have time or space here to share it all but Patti wants to take some of that study and include it in this issue, so between us both, here goes Hopefully, it will get you thinking.

Much has been taught concerning the words we say, like don't "confess that". And there is truth to that, but it's not the whole story. What many don't realize is that God is oftentimes dealing with what lies beneath the surface of our words.

I want to share something I heard years after I did this study. Mildred Coffey, in her message, Casting Out Thoughts, said:

Watch your thoughts - they become words.
Watch your words - they become actions.
Watch your actions - they become habits.
Watch your habits - they become you.

The battleground is the mind. Cast out the thoughts that the enemy is trying to plant in your mind so that they cannot take root and spring up to bear evil fruit in your life.

Mark 7:21-23 says, "*For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.*"

Since deceit is what launched this study we'll start with that. The word

“*deceit*” in that passage comes from the Strong’s #1388 - to decoy, trick (bait), wile. My interpretation was “sneaky”!

However, in seeing that passage of Scripture, it occurred to me that the first thing mentioned was “*evil thoughts.*” Following *evil thoughts, are adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, etc.*

A Choice to Sin

“*Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall.*” (1 Cor 10:12)

It dawned on me - we don’t make the choice to fall into any sin without “thinking” about it first. What we “think” about can lead us into sin. We only yield to temptation because we’ve already thought about it.

For example, let’s look at “*adulteries*” which is listed after “*evil thoughts*”. In Matt 5:28, Jesus says, “*But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.*” That word “lust” comes from Strong’s #1937, to set the heart upon, i.e. long for (rightfully or otherwise). If you are “setting your heart” towards something, you are most certainly thinking about it! Let’s take this a step further. If you are a married man or woman and are engaging in pornography, you are an adulterer. If you are having sexual relations with your wife or husband, yet are fantasizing about another partner, you are committing adultery. There’s no wiggle room for lustful thoughts. No excuse works. Lust is a powerful force and not to be tinkered with.

What about “*murders*”? 1 John 3:15 tells us, “*Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.*” Murder can have its roots in not forgiving others. If we don’t “turn the battle at the gate” our hateful, murderous thoughts against others could lead to acts of physical violence. These are things that proceed out of the heart of men. They are thought about. It seems to me that evil thoughts are really the “strongman”. As we said before, our battle starts in the mind. What we “think on” can eventually be what we do or say - good and bad.

Let’s backtrack to “*For from within, out of the heart of men*” It’s interesting to note in the Strong’s Concordance (#2588) that the word “*heart*” is “*kardia*”. Most of us are familiar with the medical word “*cardio*” which pertains to the heart. The Greek word “*kardia*” means the heart, i.e. (fig) the thoughts or feelings (mind); also (by anal.) the middle.

We include this information about the heart because so many Scriptures

join the heart to thoughts and imaginations. When we look at connecting our thoughts and imaginations to what comes out of the heart, there may be some additional answers as to why there is so much heart disease.

A perfect example is found in John 13:2 which tells us, *“And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him.”* This was Judas' “kardia” which lent itself to betrayal, and eventually became so diseased that he committed suicide. Remember, the kardia is also the thoughts or feelings (mind).

Do you want to know God better?

Then you must realize that your imaginations and your thoughts can grieve Him. In Genesis He was so deeply grieved that He brought the great flood!

Gen 6:5-6 - *“And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.”*

Let's look at the word imagine. *“And let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.”* (Zech 7:10b) *“And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbour.”* (Zech 8:17)

Both of these “imagine's” comes from Strong's 2803 which means to weave, fabricate, plot or contrive (usually in a malicious sense); hence (from the mental effort) to think, regard, value, compute.

When we are plagued by bad thoughts towards another person, often-times there is a need to forgive. Perhaps they've said or done something that has offended or hurt us. We think about that and begin to mull it over in our minds. We start thinking “well if they say this, then I'll say that.” I call it shadow boxing. We fabricate “what if's”. These are all imaginations and they aren't good ones! Stop, turn the battle at the gate, forgive them and pray for them. The devil hates when that happens!

Let us point out that born-again Christians struggle with these issues - if they will be honest about it. If you don't think that is true than become part of a deliverance ministry!

“Curse not the king, no not in thy thought.” (Eccl 10:20a) Did you realize you can actually curse people with just your thoughts?

“But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, self-willed, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.” (2 Pet 2:10) Watch your words - they become actions. The word “despise” means “**think against**”. Government speaks of authority - God, parents, employers, pastors, teachers, elected officials - the list goes on. Granted, not all those in authority do the right thing. That is no excuse for us. We are to pray for those in authority over us - not despise or think against them.

“Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil.” (Pro 12:20) Could deceit be one of the roots to evil imaginations?

“The rebellious walk after their own thoughts.” (Isaiah 65:2)

“O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?” (Jeremiah 4:14) “Vain” is Strong’s 205 'aven (aw-ven'); from an unused root perhaps meaning properly, to pant (hence, to exert oneself, usually in vain; to come to naught); strictly nothingness; also trouble. vanity, wickedness; specifically an idol.

David said, *“I hate vain thoughts.”* Do we hate them?

“But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be My people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward.” (Jer 7:23-24) Walking in evil imaginations is backsliding. It all starts in the mind! If you let vain, evil, familiar thoughts run loose in your mind, it won’t be long until you are doing what you are thinking. And you will wake up one day and find that you have gone backward and not forward. Watch your actions - they become habits. Let’s turn the battle at the gate!

“These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto Him: ... (18) An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations ..” (Pro 6:16-19) Deviseth is Strong’s 2790, (from the idea of secrecy) to be silent. What do you think about when you’re alone?

“He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way that is not good; he abhorreth not evil.” (Ps 36:4) Deviseth here is the same as “imagine” in Zechariah.

How Do We Get Rid of Bad Thoughts?

1. You have to repent! Stop, turn around, let the blood of Jesus wash your mind.
2. Say out loud to the devil, “I renounce your thoughts you have been giving me!”
3. You cannot be passive and expect to overcome.
4. Look for the way to escape the temptations.

2 Cor 10:5 tells us we are to be, *“Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;”*

Casting - Strong’s 2507 - to lower with violence, demolish, pull down.

High - Strong’s 5313 - a barrier, an elevated place or thing

Bringing - Strong’s 163 - to make captive (from 164) a prisoner of war, i.e. a captive

Captivity - same as Bringing

If we don’t bring our thoughts into captivity, our thoughts will bring us into captivity!

This is spiritual warfare! We are taking our authority, which is “in the name of Jesus”, and commanding these evil, wicked spirits (thoughts) to leave us.

*“If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if **thou hast thought evil**, lay thine hand upon thy mouth.”* (Pro 30:32) Watch your thoughts - they become words.

One of the greatest tools God has given us to deal with the issues of our thoughts and imaginations is a Scripture we are all familiar with. It is found in Phil 4:8.

“Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.”

We challenge you to begin to take inventory of your thoughts. Let the Holy Spirit begin to show you where your thoughts and imaginations are not lining up to the Word of God. The Holy Spirit will help you. Perhaps these word comparisons will help you.

True - true (as not concealing), truth - If it's not true, it's false, which means not in accordance with fact or reality, disloyal, lying, artificial. Watch out for lying thoughts about yourself and others.

Honest - venerable, honorable - If it's not honest, it's dishonest, which means lacking in uprightness or fairness, inclined to cheat, steal, defraud or deceive. Are you stealing time from your boss?

Just - equitable (in character or act), by implication, innocent, holy, right - If it's not just, it's unjust, which means unrighteous, unfair, not in accordance with legal justice. That's not just the laws of the land, that's God's laws and doing the right thing. When you ask Him to help you do the right thing, you are inviting Him to deal with the little things. Don't dismiss His quiet, still voice. It's not for others to see you do the right thing, it's because you love Him enough to do the right thing - when no one is looking!

Pure - properly, clean, i.e. (figuratively) innocent, modest, perfect: chaste - If it's not pure, it's impure, which means not clean, unwholesome, mixed with a foreign or inferior substance, not virtuous in thought, word or deed. Sexual uncleanness, masturbation, hoarding, wearing revealing clothing. Think about what you put on your body. Will your choices cause a brother or sister to lust.

Lovely - friendly towards, acceptable - If it's not lovely, it's unlovely, which means unattractive, unpleasant. Think about what people see when they look at you. Do you smile? Will you let someone go ahead of you in the grocery line who only has a few items?

Good Report - well spoken of, reputable - If it's not a good report, it's a bad report, which basically is being negative about everything. Think first - speak last. If it doesn't uplift, encourage, edify or bring a smile, maybe it doesn't need to be said at all.

Virtue - manliness (valor), i.e. excellence - If it's not virtue and excellence, it's dishonorable, unethical and immoral.

Praise - laudation; concretely, a commendable thing - If it's not praise, it's criticism, which means judging in a disapproving way. Tell someone what a good job they are doing and mean it.

Check Yourself Daily!

We have to check ourselves daily to see if we're in the faith. Because the enemy creeps up, and he puts thoughts in our head in our weakest moment, like when you're tired, angry or frustrated. Thoughts like, "there is no hope for me," or "I've committed the unpardonable sin," or "I've just got to get out of here".

What makes matters worse is the demon spirits try and make you say the thought "out loud". Demon spirits can't read your mind. I can't find a Scripture that supports that. But if you confess "out loud" what they have been whispering to you, then you've just come into agreement with those spirits. Now they know you were listening to them and will double up their attacks.

Bottom Line! – Demons want to destroy your relationship with the Lord and they use your thoughts to try and accomplish their goal.

Are you going to let them?

It really all boils down to turning the battle at the gate. When you start to have evil, bad thoughts, STOP. If you don't know what to think, pray in tongues! It is easier to think bad thoughts. It takes effort to think good. Some of our thought patterns have been with us since birth. They are in the family line. Some have been acquired through life's events. They've come from all different sources. It's another area in our life that has been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb but we have to exercise and appropriate the tools God has given us to get it right. It affords us a lifestyle of having the peace of God as stated in Phil 4:7. **“And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”**

If, after reading this, you still think "I can think whatever I want. Who's going to know?" The Holy Spirit knows everything we think. Yes, it is our choice. But please don't wander in the wilderness too long. You can die out there. Watch your habits - they become you.

When Christ is in you, you will be rejected because people are rejecting the Christ who is in you. Noah condemned the world by his righteousness, by the way he lived. Today you are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. You can expect rejection if you are going to follow Christ. You are to welcome it, rejoice and be exceedingly glad as approved of God and consider yourself blessed. The world hated Jesus before it hated you. When you are a lukewarm fence rider nobody who is in the world ever says anything, but when you want to follow God fully, you are some kind of 'weirdo' to the world. Then Geri teaches about the evil spirit of rejection that operates in us called an unloving anti-Christ spirit. The principality of rejection works closely with the principality of fear. This monster rules over many lesser fears. Geri lists those fears which plague most of us and have come down our generational lines or have entered us through trauma. All of these evil spirits have their roots in idolatry. Let us seek to be free from these tormentors. Deliverance prayers follow this teaching.

[16LHCD5-5](#) [CD - \$4.00] or [16LHDVD5-5](#) [DVD - \$6.00] - **Carla Butaud - THE CURSE OF TAMAR** - This teaching is about breaking desolation off people's lives. It comes in through the Curse of Tamar. There are so many beautiful, single Christian women who want to be married but have no prospects and they remain desolate. Read II Samuel 13 and learn what happened to Tamar. Amnon, her half-brother, was 'sick with love' (lust) for her. He knew that a relationship with her was off limits (rebellion), but he was driven by temptation (obsession). An evil spirit had taken him over. Amnon deceived her (plotted a conspiracy with seducing spirits) and forced her to lay with him (rape). Then he hated her (anger, resentment, bitterness, shame, self-hatred .. the familiar spirits

of a rapist) with hatred greater than the love he had for her (betrayal). The devil lured him into sin, then mocked and reviled him for succumbing to evil. Tamar was totally devastated. No more virginity, beautiful garments, hopes or dreams for this Princess. From that day she lived a lonely life of exile in her brother Absalom's house. Years later, Absalom plotted and conspired to have Amnon killed (revenge and murder). The iniquities of the father, King David, were visited upon his children. Deliverance prayers follow this teaching.

16LHCD5-6 [CD - \$4.00] or 16LHDVD5-6 [DVD - \$6.00] - Geri McGhee - PEOPLE PLEASER - Some of us are extreme, habitual people pleasers, some are moderate people pleasers, and some try to please people every now and then, but God demands that we give 100% of our pleasing to Him. He commands that we align our lives according to His Word. He will bless us when we suffer for doing His will, because we entrust our soul to a faithful Creator who will always do what is right and will reward us in Heaven. If we live to please man we are going to suffer the consequences of not having God's favor, plus all the judgment and demons that come with those choices. People pleasing is one of the many fruits of rejection. It works with multiple spirits of fear. People pleasers wear themselves out jumping through the hoops of others. In the quest for pleasing people, they will be bowing down to the idol of acceptance of self and the approval of man. They say, "Do not reject me or be mad at me, do not be angry or upset with me." People pleasers are cowards who enable other people. God pleasers will speak the truth in love regardless of the consequences. Revelation 21:11 says, "The cowardly and unbelieving will not inherit the Kingdom of Heaven." Deliverance prayers follow this teaching.

16LHCD5-7A & 7B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 16LHDVD5-7 - Randy Richey - IDOLATRY - Every sin we ever do begins with idolatry. Idolatry is when we think our feelings, emotions and reactions are more important than what God says. The definition of idolatry: The worship of a physical object as a god, an immoderate attachment or devotion to something, to love or admire to excess. We need to repent for our nation, because it is given over to idolatry. In our capitol, the structure of Freemasonry and pagan symbolism is unbelievable. It goes back to Simeramus, the wife of Nimrod, and pagan worship in Babylon. That is
