### **WILL YOU BE READY?**

This morning, as I prayed for many people on our prayer list I was thinking about fathers who have passed away. I began to think about the day that my father passed away. It was the morning of my wedding to my current husband, my only husband. My wedding was three hours away from where my parents lived. We had all traveled and were spending the night in hotel rooms. My dad was sick, but he gave his all to be there for me. On Friday night we had the rehearsal dinner. My father was too weak to go. Knowing that my dad was probably not going to have the strength to be at my wedding the next day, and not able to walk me down the aisle, my fiancé recommended that we do a private ceremony in the hotel room where my dad was. We got the pastors, my parents and my fiancé's dad in the hotel room with a couple others. I was dressed in my wedding dress. My husband was dressed in his tux and we had a private ceremony. On the way to my parents' hotel room I had to walk outside down the walkway to go from my room to their room and due to the width of my dress it brushed against an air conditioning vent that was outside one of the hotel rooms. Some of the dirt from the vent got on my dress. That night I saw that there was dirt on my dress and I wanted to get it cleaned for my wedding. So, the next morning I got up early and went to find a dry cleaner that could clean my dress guickly. While I was at the dry cleaners taking care of that my dad died. I was not with him. I was not even close to being by his side when he passed away. And so today, as I was thinking through that, I had another thought. What if I'm "out getting my garment cleaned" when Jesus comes for His bride? I often think about Jesus coming back for His bride in our garments white, without spot or wrinkle (Ephesians 5:27). I thought, when Jesus comes for His bride will she be ready or will she still be trying to get her dress cleaned and not there when He comes. He may return in my lifetime. He may return in my

24LHCD11-1A & 1B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD11-1 [DVD - \$5.00] - Randy Richey - DELIVERANCE FROM INIQUITY - What is sin? Randy targets transgressions of the law that many people believe have been done away with. We do have a new covenant, new high priest, perfect blood that has met all the atonement requirements, and a new temple. However, the standard for living is still the same. Idolatry, murder, adultery, incest, tattoes, theft, etc. remain unacceptable in our lives as believers. If you no longer care you are in a dangerous spot. True repentance ignites the mercies of God and paves the way for deliverance, healing and restoration to your relationship with your Heavenly Father. This message is packed full of prayer and teaching that will help you in your walk towards spiritual freedom.

**24LHCD11-2** [CD - \$4.00] or **24LHDVD11-2** [DVD - \$5.00] - Laquitta Sizemore - <u>SPIRIT OF DECEPTION</u> - To deceive and snare us is likely the most profound strategy of the enemy. And to snare us he has to deceive us. A deception can't happen without the deceiver knowing the truth. Likewise, we have the Truth to discern the deception of the enemy. We must stay in the Word! The enemies' major goals are to steal your identity and keep you from the truth about who you are in Christ, keep you from the truth about who your enemy is, and keep you in deceit about the power and authority you have over the enemy. Deception is not knowing that you are being deceived. The first one to be deceived was satan by thinking he could be like God. Pay special attention to the insight the Holy Spirit has given her in Genesis 3:1-16 & 1 Timothy 2:13-14. Prayers of deliverance conclude this service.

**24LHCD11-3 [CD - \$4.00]** or **24LHDVD11-3 [DVD - \$5.00] - Charles Jernigan - SATAN'S TEMPTATIONS** - Many Christians fall when yielding to the persistent temptations from the enemy. The first reference is Genesis 3:1-5. The devil recognized the special anointing upon Adam and Eve. They were without sin, walking in pure holiness, covered in God's glory. His strategic temptation was to challenge the Word of God. We must guard our hearts and minds from ingesting doctrines of demons, manipulating Scripture to have it fit our lifestyle. Some would not consider this to be a temptation but the Word is simple. Sin is what the Bible says it is. Temptation is like a fishing lure. It looks like food but it's got hooks in it. Various examples are given where satan uses the tactics of temptation to destroy our testimony and steal our anointing. Service ends with deliverance ministry.

24LHCD11-4 [CD - \$4.00] or 24LHDVD11-4 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Vails - DEFEATING THE SPIRIT OF PRIDE - Pride is a stronghold that can take hold of a person's life. Sometimes we put

ourselves on an altar, which then becomes idolatry and that is not acceptable. A number of Scriptural symptoms of pride are presented. They all defy God and fight the working of the Holy Spirit in our lives. God resists the family of pride. It will keep you from reaching your potential in God. It will cause you to "work things out on your own." We set ourselves up for failure and burnout when pride is at work. When we see these symptoms taking over our lives we must immediately take the necessary measures to get them out before we are stuck in them. God will help us when we approach Him with a spirit of humility. Deliverance prayers conclude this message.

24LHCD11-5A & 5B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD11-5 [DVD - \$5.00] - Jesse Jernigan - NEW AGE SERPENT SPIRITS - Luke 10:17-20 clearly identifies the power we have to defeat the serpent and scorpion spirits. Examining the origin of the python serpent spirit shows any form of divination will bring in a python spirit. Another serpent spirit is kundalini. It comes from India where kundalini yoga is practiced. There is a specific yoga pose called the Cobra pose alluding to the identity of this serpent spirit. This style of yoga seeks to uncoil the cobra at the base of the spine through a series of panorama, sounds and meditation. It focuses on awakening and raising dormant energy. Just because you replace the word kundalini yoga with Christian yoga doesn't mean that it is not an abominable practice according to the Bible. It's deception! Deliverance prayers follow the teaching.

**24LHCD11-6 [CD - \$4.00] or 24LHDVD11-6 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Vails - GOD WILL FIGHT FOR YOU** - How does God fight for you? Jesus is seated at the right hand of the Father and He is making intercession for you!! When the enemy shall come in like a flood the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him. We should be grateful for that standard that God raises for us. The Blood of Jesus is what covers us and we want to stay under that Blood. We want the convicting power of the Holy Ghost to keep us straight in our relationship with God. The thread that ties this message together is that "God will be your defense!" You don't have to defend yourself. The enemy is out for blood and the church must arise and take its rightful place in the body and the earth realm. God is going to use His people if we submit to Him. This encouraging teaching is a must listen to.

24LHCD11-7A & 7B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD11-7 [DVD - \$5.00] - Randy Richey - THE TRUTH THAT DESTROYS THE LIES - A problem for many is a blocking of the love of God coming into their life. Not that He is not sending it. We've got receiver problems. The number one benefit of being born again is being at peace with God and number two is being at peace with yourself. Then we are to be at peace with our neighbor. There is a difference between a peace keeper and a peacemaker. The majority of this recording is devoted to Randy presenting exercises for the listeners to hear the voice of God. Example: How do I view, sense or see my Father in Heaven? Then, Father God, is there a lie that I am believing about You? Then, Lord, where did I learn this lie? This helpful ministry throughout the service broke through the lies of the enemy by exposing the truth.

#### 24LHCD11-8A & 8B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or <u>24LHDVD11-8</u> - Various Speakers

<u>Deborah Vails - STAY THE COURSE</u> - Hebrews 12:1-3 is the foundation of this inspirational mini-message. Don't give into the flesh just because it's weak. Don't make excuses. Yield to the Spirit of the Lord. Let God push you and press you forward, no matter what the circumstances. A prophetic word is given at the conclusion.

<u>Laquitta Sizemore - HOLINESS</u> - God wouldn't tell us to be holy if we couldn't be holy. There is a level of holiness and piety that makes you unattainable to the enemy and makes him powerless over

you. After all the deliverance that is attained at a camp meeting, it's you and God going home. As you move forward into holiness, beware the enemy will come at you with spiritual pride.

<u>Jesse Jernigan - SPIRITUAL TOOLS</u> - We are pointed to a number of tools to help us in our daily walk with the Lord. With that is the admonition to push and fight through the flesh and the enemy which both fight us from different directions. It boils down to putting off the old man and putting on the new, as we unlearn the old lies and learn the truth.

<u>Charles Jernigan - LEGAL GROUND</u> - Sin is the culprit for the enemy to have legal ground. We must walk away from sin. Suspicious minds produce unholy judgements against others. A suspicious mind has been an enemy he has had to fight, but praying to see people as Christ sees them is the remedy. If we walk in freedom, we have words of life to give. Don't leave any cracks for the enemy.

<u>Callie Richey - WHAT IS LOVE?</u> - Because she was rejected from birth, she heard everything through rejected ears. Now, she is so rooted in who God says she is that whenever her character is attacked, she knows who she is in Christ and the lies don't dissuade her. We have to learn what love is. She found her answers in the Word of God. Wonderful testimony!

Randy & Callie Richey - A FATHER CONFESSES & A MOTHER CONFESSES - Randy stands as a representative of a father, grandfather, uncle or any man that ever hurt, harmed, rejected, abandoned, forsook, or betrayed you. He asks for forgiveness for a plethora of different damaging actions that might have had devastating consequences in the listener's lives. Callie then repeats this process as the representative of a mother, grandmother, etc. Profound deep healings occurred during this ministry.

## REPENTANCE by Pastor Chris Simpson

#### Sin Will Be Exposed!

One of the reasons we don't look at our own sinfulness is because of what the book of Hebrews calls "the deceitfulness of sin" (Hebrews 3:13). Sin is deceitful because you can act like it's not really that bad, or that somehow you can get away with it. This is a lie that has caused many to hide their sin.

But God always judges sin, no matter how much we might try to cover it up. We see this truth illustrated by an event which is recorded in the book of Joshua.

"But the Israelites acted unfaithfully in regard to the devoted things; Achan son of Carmi, the son of Zimri, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took some of them. So the Lord's anger burned against Israel." (Joshua 7:1)

When the children of Israel crossed over the Jordan to the land God had promised them, He commissioned them to drive out the pagan inhabitants of the land. All went well until one man, Achan, chose to disobey what God had said and took for himself cursed loot from Jericho (see Joshua 7:1). Joshua, not knowing this and without seeking the Lord first, went on to spy out Ai, the next city they were to take. When his spies returned saying that the city should fall easily, Joshua went to battle against it, but instead of the victory he expected, disaster ensued.

"So about three thousand men went up there from the people, but they fled before the men of Ai. And the men of Ai struck down about thirty-six men, for they chased them from before the gate as far as Shebarim, and struck them down on the descent; therefore the hearts of the people melted and became like water." (Joshua 7:4-5)

Israel fell before their enemies because Achan believed that his act of disobedience was a secret that no one would ever know about. Instead, it affected the entire nation and caused the deaths of 36 men. The same is true of you when you think you can hide a sin or an indulgence. There are always consequences to sin. It will affect every part of your life: your countenance, your attitudes, and your relationships. It will rob you of your peace. Many may never experience Jesus through you because you are preoccupied with yourself or full of guilt because of this "hidden" area of sin.

Remember the fable of the "Princess and the Pea?" The princess was made very uncomfortable by something as small as a pea under her mattress. No matter how many mattresses she piled on top of that pea, she could never rid herself of the discomfort caused by its presence! In the same way, even a speck of sin affects your life, and you can never really hide it. Let's look at what happened next to Joshua and Israel.

"Then Joshua tore his clothes, and fell to the earth on his face before the ark of the Lord until evening, he and the elders of Israel; and they put dust on their heads. And Joshua said, "Alas, Lord God, why have You brought this people over the Jordan at all--to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us? ... O Lord, what shall I say when Israel turns its back before its enemies?... So the Lord said to Joshua: "Get up! Why do you lie thus on your face? Israel has sinned, and they have also transgressed My covenant which I commanded them. For they have even taken some of the accursed things, and have both stolen and deceived; and they have also put it among their own stuff." (Joshua 7:6-11)

How amazing that God would actually tell someone to stop praying. The message is clear: don't even bother praying if you are harboring secret sin. God will not countenance a person who seeks Him on one hand while hiding sin on the other. In the book of Isaiah, God tells His people, "Hear the word of the Lord, You rulers of Sodom; Give ear to the law of our God, You people of Gomorrah: 'To what

purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me? ... When you spread out your hands, I will hide My eyes from you; Even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood. Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; Put away the evil of your doings from before My eyes. Cease to do evil." (see Isaiah 1:10-16) Notice that God calls His chosen people "Sodom and Gomorrah!" He basically lets them know that they have two choices: they can be holy or filthy. Anything else is phony. There is no middle ground. This is why He tells Joshua not to even bother praying until he has dealt with the sin in their midst.

Some of the most demonized people I have encountered are people who claim to "love the Lord." These individuals will go on and on about their relationship with Jesus, but all the while you just sense something is not right. This is often because these same people are justifying an area of sin in their lives, and you discern the phoniness. They claim to love God, and yet they are "hiding" bitterness, judgment, or some other area of sin in the tent of their lives.

"Now Joshua said to Achan, "My son, I beg you, give glory to the Lord God of Israel, and make confession to Him, and tell me now what you have done; do not hide it from me." (Joshua 7:19)

Achan could not hide. Discernment was given to the spiritual leadership to ferret out the source of the sin that was affecting the nation. As Jesus said, "Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops." (Luke 12:3) What he thought he could get away with is now exposed before everybody! Horribly, Achan's entire family was destroyed with him because of his sin (see Joshua 7:24-26). How many families are destroyed because a parent chooses to indulge an area of sinfulness?

The first step on the road to repentance is to bring your struggle with sin into the light. 1 John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Confessing means to bring it to the light. Jesus said, "He who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God" (John 3:21).

But, this is just the beginning. The thought is completed in Proverbs 28:13, which states, "He that covers his sins shall not prosper: but whose confesses and forsakes them shall have mercy." You must forsake your sin in addition to confessing it. Even those who are willing to confess their sins may have difficulty forsaking them when they experience temptations. The reason for this is that there is little godly sorrow leading to repentance. As we shall see, true repentance is always an outworking of godly sorrow. There are certain doctrines of faith that are especially instrumental to a believer having a strong foundation in Christ. These particular beliefs are laid out the by the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Hebrews: "Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.(Heb 6:1-2)

Notice that the very first foundational principle is repentance. Without a true understanding of repentance, what it is, and how it manifests in our lives, we will never grow into maturity or gain victory over the enemy's devices. Many churches do not teach repentance but that doesn't give you a get out of jail free card! Paper booklet - 43 pages
