24LHCD12-1 [CD - \$4.00] or <u>24LHDVD12-1</u> [DVD - \$5.00] - Randy Richey - <u>DESTROYING</u> <u>TECHNOLOGICAL SORCERY</u> - (YouTube removed but it is available on Rumble) In this teaching he sets the table for God's people to launch into a whole new level of prayer and intercession. These adversaries are not going away and will only intensify but prayer will sustain you. Technological sorcery is a form of witchcraft that manipulates through elements, specifically earth, wind, fire and rain. It has multiple purposes, including but not limited to weather control, making us sick and knocking our immune systems down. He shares personal testimony of his experiences witnessing some of the results of this elemental sorcery. The schemes of the enemy's invasion and manipulation of human DNA is exposed in the context of this message. He explains the "internet of all things" and its ultimate goal for total connectivity. We are made of dust, breath, nervous system and water, i.e. earth, wind, fire and rain. These technological sorcery demons are being positioned for the physical manipulation of our bodies. Deliverance prayers and ministry throughout this teaching.

24LHCD12-2 [CD - \$4.00] or 24LHDVD12-2 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Vails - WALKING STRAIGHT AND UPRIGHT BEFORE GOD - She begins with the analogy of our physical back and our spiritual walk both needing to be straight and in alignment. Our relationship with God must first be in alignment vertically. The horizontal has a lot to do with our attitudes and behaviors towards others. When the vertical is in proper order, the horizontal can line up. In the physical sense, God created certain parts of our spine to include the cervical, thoracic and lumbar. These areas are broken down anatomically into C1-C7 (Cervical); T1-T12 (Thoracic) and L1-L5 (Lumbar). In this teaching she references each of these and how they impact different physiological aspects of our body. She serves up some food for thought concerning divine healing and medical intervention. An encouraging word and prayers for healing conclude this message which primarily is centered on the love of God.

24LHCD12-3A & 3B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD12-3 [DVD - \$5.00] - Kernaa Williams - DON'T <u>REJOICE BECAUSE THE SPIRITS ARE SUBJECT UNTO YOU</u> - A foundation is laid to confirm one's name can be removed from the Book of Life. This message is not given to condemn, but if the Holy Spirit convicts, then attention should hopefully be given. The crucial truth presented here should make us all stop and ask the Holy Spirit to help us take inventory of our motives and objectives as they pertain to the Kingdom of God. It's time for conviction to come on the body of Christ. Luke 10:17-20 brings a stern warning to those who move in the deliverance ministry. We are not to rejoice in our gifts and abilities over demonic spirits. Jeremiah 9:23-24 gives us God's heart and mind regarding this issue. Additionally, we should be rejoicing that our names should be written in the Lamb's Book of Life! Service concludes with a call to the altar.

24LHCD12-4A & 4B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD12-4[DVD - \$5.00] - Jean Williams - THEGLORY REVEALS - The term "Glory" is used to describe the manifestation of God's presence. His presence, majesty and splendor will be revealed in us and that is worth every trial we face in this life. (Rom 8:18) God's presence responds to true worship and demons flee. When David played the harp, the evil spirits left Saul. God yearns for our worship, that we be true worshippers. If there are things in your life you are having problems with, get into worship. True worship is an inward attitude that comes from the heart. The results will bring change in you, even if your circumstances don't change. You will see the Glory revealed. She goes deeper into this teaching, sharing more "Glory reveals." The more of His Glory that is in you, the less effort it takes to expel darkness. Kernaa and Jean conclude this service by ministering deliverance to the saints of God.

24LHCD12-5A & 5B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or <u>24LHDVD12-5</u> [DVD - \$5.00] - Randy Richey - <u>YOU</u> <u>NEED DELIVERANCE</u> - Every sin has some idolatry right in front of it because you are choosing sin over God. If you don't forgive yourself you are making your opinion an idol. Sin is a terrible taskmaster and its wages are death. It's not that complicated. When you are tempted to sin, do the opposite. If pornography is your problem, run to the light. Get out of the dark place you are practicing the sin. If it's gluttony, eat the Words of God. (Jer 15:16) The deliverance you get from the demons leaving, is only anchored by you choosing to do something different when you go home. Randy shares some barriers and misconceptions both to deliverance and on demonology and deliverance glorifying the devil. He devotes a segment to a list of, "You know you need deliverance when ...". Prayers of deliverance are ministered throughout this service.

24LHCD12-6A & 6B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD12-6 [DVD - \$5.00] - *Jean & **Kernaa Williams - *UNDERSTANDING FORGIVENESS AND SPIRITUAL WARFARE - **MANIPULATIVE MIND CONTROL - *Forgiveness liberates and transforms us. While we are holding on to anger and unforgiveness we are in darkness and in satan's kingdom. Walking in obedience restores the relationship and fellowship with God and gives us joy that we can't have when we are rebelling and refusing to obey. Why is forgiveness spiritual warfare? It fights against certain forces or desires of our flesh. Because of the depth of what has been done that is so hard to forgive, the flesh doesn't want you to forgive. Satan despises forgiveness! He is the accuser, so therefore forgiveness is his sworn enemy. It contradicts his existence. He does not want you to forgive because he knows it's the secret to your deliverance. She shares helpful ways to cultivate forgiveness.**This message was launched as a result of a friend of his who was concerned because mind control techniques were going to be introduced into the church he was attending. The reason being "it would help the church grow." It's time for awareness of what is slithering into the churches. The Jonestown massacre and its horrific details was a result of mind control techniques operating through "Rev. Jim Jones". Kernaa profiles this "charismatic" self-proclaimed prophet, exposing the anti-christ spirit and his many angel of light

gifts. How did it get that far and why? Because the people got their focus off of Jesus Christ and they began to glory in a man. And as a result, nine hundred people died. A person with a wounded spirit is an easy target for being manipulated. We are in a season when God wants true apostolic and prophetic ministries to be a voice. The call of the hour is for greater discerning of spirits! Deliverance ministry concludes these two timeless and sobering messages.

24LHCD12-7 [CD - **\$4.00**] or **24LHDVD12-7** [DVD - **\$5.00**] - **Deborah Vails** - **WALKING IN THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT** - (Deborah gave a young couple who were in attendance for the first time, the opportunity to both share the healing testimonies they received at this camp meeting.) The Holy Spirit leads believers to a greater understanding of the gospel, in addition to general help and guidance. The Holy Spirit will only tell you the Truth and help you apply the Truth to your circumstances. When you pray in the Spirit the Lord is able to guide you how to pray so you are fruitful. She shares seven things that Jesus said the Holy Spirit would do for us. The Lord wants us to understand how much power there is in the Holy Spirit and to walk in it! The Holy Spirit doesn't do anything of Himself. He speaks from the Father. So when you hear from Him you are hearing from the Father. A multitude of attributes are given to help us believe, receive and understand the Holy Spirit's place, power and provision in our lives. Service ends with a call to the altar to receive the Holy Spirit.

24LHCD12-8A & 8B [2 CD Set - \$6.00] or 24LHDVD12-8 [DVD - \$5.00] - VARIOUS SPEAKERS Deborah Vails: HOW TO RETAIN DELIVERANCE - She presents a number of principles for how to retain deliverance, starting first with putting on the whole armor of God. Refuse thoughts from the enemy and replace them with the Word of God. Resist the devil at the first sign of attack. Declare and confess the Word of God. Stay in the Word. Crucify the flesh. Develop a life of continuous praise. Maintain a life of fellowship and keep yourself under authority. Commit yourself all the way to Jesus. Implement these disciplines and you will grow in the Lord.

Laquitta Sizemore: GO AND SIN NO MORE - Deliverance is not a "one and done". It's a lifestyle. Sin is the open door that allows the demons to come in. Stay out of your past. Don't let the enemy bring up the things you have repented of and been set free from. Going forward just follow Jesus and take the narrow path. She shares how this camp meeting has been the best ever for her as God has used every speaker to minister to her things He has had her praying over the last several months. She asked the Lord to "pressure wash" her heart with the Blood of Jesus. If you pray this, get a deep seat and hang on because He will reveal to you what is in your heart that you didn't know was there. Her heart says, "God show me the truth in it!"

Randy Richey: KEEPING YOUR VICTORY AND GODDESS DESTRUCTION - Incorporated into this message are various "nuggets" that will help you keep your victory. God gave us instructions for holy living so He could bless us and we wouldn't have to be cursed. The curse really means access of the devil to you because you won't listen to God. Don't take counsel from demons! The Spirit of Truth leads us into Truth. The best prayer is "Lord, help me!". You have to love yourself enough to guard your own soul. He expounds on the value God places in each of us and the victory there is of having our confidence in the Lord and not ourselves. Randy takes us through a plethora of deliverance prayers primarily relating to goddess demons. It's important to be willing to allow the Holy Spirit to minister to you even if you do not recognize a named spirit as it could be affecting you through the authority of a generational placement.

REPENTANCE by Pastor Chris Simpson

A Little Leaven Leavens the Whole Lump

In 1 Corinthians 5, Paul tells the story of a sin problem that arose in the Corinthian church. A man was having an affair with a woman, probably his step-mother. In Vs. 2 Paul writes, "You are puffed up and have not rather mourned." What is interesting is that Paul was not rebuking the man who had the affair, but rather the Corinthian church itself. It was winking at the sin and not addressing it. Paul expressed disbelief that they would tolerate the unrepentant man in their midst.

I was once part of a charismatic Episcopal Church that was full of fire and holiness. Unfortunately, after a number of years, it began to drift from its roots, allowing an openly homosexual man to be in the church without confronting him. When I found out about this, I went to the pastor and asked him why they let him stay. The pastor said, "Brother, we just need to love him and accept him where he is." I left a few months later, after having been there 12 years. In verse 6, Paul warns the Corinthians that, "A little leaven leavens the whole lump!" If you tolerate only a little sin, eventually it is going to spread, and that is what has happened. The Episcopal Church now has an openly homosexual Bishop.

The purity of the early Church was very much like the purity of early Israel. The early church was so pure that when a couple, Ananias and Sapphira, attempted to deceive the Church elders, they dropped dead. Needless to say, the fear of the Lord fell mightily on the Church. Scripture tells us that after this incident, *"Yet none of the rest dared join them..."* (Acts 5:13). Only a few verses later, we're told that Peter's very shadow healed the sick. People want the power, but they often don't want to pay the price.

Seven Evidences of True Repentance

"Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter." (2 Corinthians 7:11)

In 2 Corinthians 2:6, the Corinthian church followed Paul's admonition and excommunicated the man who was having the affair. As a result, the man repented, and Paul then exhorted the church to restore him to fellowship. Now, in referring to this incident, Paul writes some of the most powerful verses of commendation in the Bible, but, Paul does not praise the man's repentance; instead, he praises the church's repentance from their passive attitude toward blatant sin in their midst!

Notice that Paul makes a distinct contrast in 2 Corinthians 7:10 between godly sorrow and what he calls "the sorrow of the world." Worldly sorrow results in regret and anxiety. It may cause people to go to the altar, weep, and have a lot of emotion, but it never results in a genuine turning from sin. The word used by Paul for true repentance produced by godly sorrow comes from the Greek word "matanoia," which means "to change your mind, purpose, and heart and to recover your senses." The perfect example of this is the "Prodigal Son." After blowing his inheritance and finding himself in a pig pen, the young man "came to his senses" (see Luke 15:17). Or, as the King James version reads, "And when he came to himself..." The literal meaning in the Greek is, "when he woke up." Repentance means to wake up and utterly turn from sin.

In this verse, Paul lists seven evidences or manifestations of true repentance. True, godly repentance will first produce "carefulness." In other words, you'll begin exercising more care in your behavior. Recognizing your tendency to fall into the same hole time and time again, you'll do all you can to avoid it. Secondly, it produces a desire to clear yourself, to see your sinful behavior eliminated from the record of your life. Third, there is indignation. The more you think about the sin you keep falling into, the madder you get about its influence over you.

The fourth manifestation is fear. The NIV translates this word as "alarm," and the TLB reads, "anxious to be free from sin." At this point, a true "fear of the Lord" is beginning to build in you. The fear of the Lord is to hate evil! (see Proverbs 8:13) The fifth is vehement desire, or, in some translations, eagerness. This speaks of a deep, heart-felt longing to truly, once for all, change and be free from the tyranny of your sin.

True, godly repentance starts with just being more careful, and then develops into a desire for sin to stay out of your life. Then, once you begin to get mad that you keep falling over and over, the fear of

the Lord will increase and you'll begin to get fire in your bones! The sixth evidence of repentance is zeal. Jesus said in Revelation 3:17, "Be zealous and repent." Zeal is when vehement desire turns to fire. This is where a passion forms within you for righteousness and holiness. The seventh manifestation is revenge. Now you're ready to go after the demons that have conspired to keep you locked in your sin. The most powerful people in ministry are people who have gotten free from demonic activity. When you've been in bondage in a certain area but have become truly repentant, there is a passion and revenge to cast that demon out. This is why the enemy wants to keep people lukewarm.

Some events in the life of King Saul offer us a very real and sobering illustration of the difference between worldly sorrow for sin and true, godly repentance. **(To be continued)**
