**25LHMP3CD8 - 2025 Labor Day Camp Meeting on 1 MP3 CD - 8 Messages - \$10.00**

**25LHCD8-1 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-1 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Vails - [TIMES OF REFRESHING](#)** - This message begins with explosive prayers, proclamations, declarations and a plea for the fires of intercession, deliverance and prayer to never go out! The cry for repentance and submission found in Acts 3:19 and James 4:7-8 allows the anointing to flow throughout this service. All directives point to Jesus and your relationship with Him. We summarize this message with random statements made throughout the service. There must be no fear! Being linked in with Jesus will cast out all fear. Draw nigh unto God. Your whole relationship will change when you get close to Him. Respond to Him. God's fire in our lives should spread. It's a good fire! We desperately need God's presence in our lives. The anointing will carry you. The anointing will give you the ability to do what God wants you to do. When you stray away from Him go back to square one - that place where you began to walk away. That's where you begin to repent. When God gives you a directive, do it! Get back in position with God. What God thinks about you is what matters. God is calling His people to the altar. Can you get there for yourself? If you realize right now that you need to repent, that means you are going the wrong way. God is telling us to repent and be converted, that our sins be blotted out. If they are blotted out He can't see them. She captures a panoramic view of what the fire of God is. This encouraging message is for everyone who has an ear to hear what God is saying. The times of refreshing are here.

**25LHCD8-2 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-2 [DVD - \$5.00] - Richard Tate - [WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?](#)** - "God the Father ordains stuff, Jesus speaks it and the Holy Spirit does it." Richard shares some of the things the Holy Spirit is. 1) Mt 1:18 He is the one that impregnated Mary, the mother of Jesus. 2) He's the counselor. 3) He's the Spirit of Truth. 4) Your body is His temple. He lives there. Where we go He has to go. That doesn't mean He's going to partake of what we sometimes do, but He's going to be there. Don't grieve Him. He has feelings. 5) He's our earnest, our down payment of

what's coming for us. 6) All the fruit are in Him. They all come from Him. He is here to make us holy, to make us like Jesus. We think we want a little freedom, but He says, "You've got freedom. You're free from eternal damnation. You're free from sin." He's not a task master. He wants to work with us. It's a learning experience to walk with the Spirit. This teaching takes us deeper than who the Holy Spirit is and right into the very heart of God. He's looking to have a people who can show this world what holy living really is. It all has to do with the heart, obedience, being faithful and fulfilling God's will for your life. It may not be anything exciting, nor give you a big name, but give it your all, help people, and love God. Many years ago, Richard said the Lord said to him, "Why don't you trust Me?" Richard answered, "Because I trusted people most of my life and they burned me." Might that not be a similar experience for many of us? Pursue Him with your whole heart and you will learn to trust Him.

**25LHCD8-3 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-3 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Greenhill - [SITUATIONS AND PEOPLE YOU CANNOT FIX](#)** - The entire Bible is our counsel - both Old and New Testaments. The launch pad for this message is 1 Sam 27:1-7 where "David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul ..." God did not tell him to flee to the land of the Philistines, he devised that plan because his situation was so desperate he was willing to resolve it whether God was in it or not. David had slew Goliath of Gath a number of years before, but now on his own volition he is going into enemy territory. The story evolves with David and his men performing a wicked massacre to substantiate a lie. His willful decision brought him to such despair he finally sought counsel with God as to how to gain victory over the problem. In Chapter 30 we see the consequences of David's willfulness which reminds us how complicated and devastating the path can be in our lives when we are not following the leading of the Holy Spirit. And then there is the ephod. How does David get special permission to wear it? He is not a Levite. But God honored it and gave him divine direction. Interesting outcome from events going on at the same time - Saul consulting the witch of Endor and David seeking the mind of God. Follow along as she then navigates into 2 Samuel 16. Pray God gives you the grace to get through your intolerable situation and not run to the enemy's camp.

**25LHCD8-4 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-4 [DVD - \$5.00] - Jannetha Vails - [SEEK TO KNOW JESUS](#)** - Isaiah 55:1-3,6 "Ho, everyone that thirsteth come ye to the waters ...." Verse 6 of that chapter tells us to seek the Lord while He may be found and call upon Him while He is near. That is the clarion call of this message. There is insight that He wants to give us to prepare us for what is to come and give us strategies on how to pray for our families, our children, our nation. The devil has put so many distractions in our path that have separated us from Him and caused us to not be able to hear. Even in ministry we can be bombarded with distractions. If we are not connected with Jesus we cannot get the instructions we need. Before we know it we are looking for other resources instead of going to the source, Jesus. We have to let go of our "normal" and change to His normal. When we are connected to Him, He will give us the strategies to combat the enemy. He has given us authority and dominion over the earth realm but if we are not seeking Him for direction, we can't really know the truth of what's going on. He is saying, "Seek to know Me". She gives us a point by point account of who Jesus is, and then shares instructions on how to seek Him. Drawing deep into the wells of Scripture she provides us with a plethora of God's pleas to seek Him. Powerful message!

**25LHCD8-5 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHVDV8-5 [DVD - \$5.00] - Barbara Williams - [CRIMINAL MINDS](#)** - A criminal is a person who has committed a crime, an unlawful act that occurs when there is a motive, a

mean and an opportunity. The question is asked, "Who do you think was the first criminal?" The answer is found in Genesis 1. The mind is the element of a person that enables them to be aware of the world and their experiences, to think and to feel the consciousness of faculty and thought. It was in Satan's mind and heart to be as the Most High. So a criminal mind would refer to a psychological pattern and thought process of someone who commits crime characterized by a lack of empathy, disregard for rules, social norms and morals, a self-centered approach to achieving their desires. It involves criminal intent and a mindset that justifies illegal activities. Civil laws that are broken have consequences, as do God's laws that are broken. Simply stated it's the flesh man versus the spirit man. The hearts and minds of a Christian believer must be considered as we endeavor to walk in obedience to the Word of God. God's wisdom is the key factor in the process of our minds being renewed - that transformation from a criminal mind to the mind of Christ. She explores the four types of wisdom and their characteristics that God has listed for her. When we seek wisdom, we seek to know God's mind, not the criminal mind we were born into. Excellent teaching!

**25LHCD8-6 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-6 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Greenhill - [PSALM 91: Deliverance Prayer in the 1st & 2nd Temple Era](#)** - You will hear a plea for all the impurities to be flushed from us so we can do the work He has called us to do as faithful servants. He wants to keep us under the shelter of His wings. The premise of this teaching is to bring history alive to Psalm 91. Parts of Biblical wilderness land (Masada) are still being excavated to reveal buried manuscripts, ashes and various and sundry other artifacts dating back to Old Testament time frames. They are carefully being preserved and examined by scholars to reveal information that has never been made available to previous generations. The information she presents matters about what we think about Psalm 91. At the time David wrote the 91st Psalm he handed it over to Solomon, his son before he died. She reads the most ancient translation, as it was originally written by David. As narrated by her, Psalm 91 is clearly protection from demons, a deliverance session if you will. She then guides us through the KJV of Psalm 91 to see every class of modern day evils that God protects us from, i.e. political intrigue, slavery, substance abuse, human trafficking, bullying, intimidation, oppression, sudden catastrophic accidents leading to long-term hospitalization, weather warfare, volcanism, earthquakes, GMO and hybrid organisms in foods and daily use items such as atrazine laced toilet paper you may be using, financial entrapment...the list goes on and on. Just remember, the Lord is our Keeper. He provides Divine safety. May we purpose to dwell in His secret place!

**25LHCD8-7 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-7 [DVD - \$5.00] - Deborah Vails - [LIVING A DISCIPLINED LIFE](#)** - Discipline comes from the core word, disciple. A disciple is one who bases their conduct on their teacher, one who is an imitator of their teacher. How can you imitate someone you do not know? We are to follow Jesus and do as He does. We want the power of God in our lives but will it be there when He gives us a call to action? A follower is a companion. Do we have a consistent prayer life? Do we read our Bibles? Do we live a repentant life? Do we spend time in fellowship with God, learning to hear and obey the voice of the Holy Spirit? It takes discipline to live for Him. We must come out of the world and be separate. The standard is holiness. When you have surrendered your life to God it doesn't belong to you. She shares twelve areas, we as believers must discipline ourselves in. The Bible will tell you what to do, you just have to read it! She gives answers to the question, "how do we walk with God"? Are you pursuing Him? She presents twelve practical commandments for a disciplined Christian to implement in their life. We should lead a disciplined life even when others are not watching us. She ends the message by reading a word from the Lord

encouraging the listener to pursue God. Targeted prayers for deliverance of demonic strongholds conclude this anointed service.

**25LHCD8-8 [CD - \$4.00] or 25LHDVD8-8 [DVD - \$5.00] - Jannetha Vails - [THE POWER OF GOD'S WORD](#)** - Powerful decrees and declarations of Scripture ignite this message, taking us deeper into God's Word. We have to come into partnership with the Word. The foundation of this teaching originates in Matthew 8. The centurion understood authority. He believed it before he even asked, because he knew he would not have Jesus come to his house. Faith in the Word activates the power of the Word. If we do not know His Word it produces weakness which the enemy will use to his advantage. If we are following others who are not rightly dividing the Word, we can be persuaded. "Ye shall not die" is where the enemy introduced the most venomous poison to mankind - doubt. Satan told Eve their eyes would be opened and Eve saw the tree would make them wise. It represented gaining wisdom from the wrong source, a hidden source which directly disobeys God. Adam and Eve did not understand their God-given authority (Gen 1:26-28) "and over all the earth" which included the serpent. God has given us dominion. It is our responsibility to take dominion and subdue the enemy at the first sign of him rearing his ugly head. Praise God for Jesus who came to replace what was lost. ( Luke 10:19). Jesus re-established dominion through the Holy Spirit. (Acts 1:8) We cannot do this without the Holy Spirit. Everything that is not in line with the will and Word of God must be laid down. The Holy Spirit will help us. The Centurion's faith was not in what he could see, but in the authority he knew that was behind the word.

## **REPENTANCE** by Pastor Chris Simpson

(Continued from August, 2025 Issue)

### **Is "Eternal Security" Scriptural?**

*"For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world."* (1 Corinthians 11: 31-32)

In the above passage, Paul again alludes to the possibility of a believer being condemned. When I was a young Christian, I was taught to believe in what was called "eternal security." Eternal security means that once you were saved, you were going to Heaven no matter what. Holding onto this doctrine forced me to "go around" certain scriptures or try to explain them away in an awkward way.

What opened my eyes to the absolute fallacy of this belief is when my church began to go door to door, engaging in evangelism outreach. We met person after person who claimed to know Jesus and yet was obviously living an ungodly life. Many times these "believers" would get angry at even the implication that there could be anything "less than righteous" about them. It soon became clear to me what an error it is to believe that just making a "profession of faith" at some point in your life assures you of Heaven without regard to how you live out the rest of your life.

*"Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?--unless indeed you are reprobate."* (2 Corinthians 13:5)

Again, Paul warns believers of the danger of falling away from the faith. Over and over Paul warns believers not to presume on their walk with God. This means that just because you have walked the aisle to "get saved," you are not now free to live like the devil and still expect to go to Heaven. Paul clearly warns how men can fall away from belief in the following passage from 2 Timothy:

*“But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith.” (2 Timothy 3:1-8)*

We're told here that reprobation occurs when your mind becomes corrupted as a result of resisting the truth. Scripture says that God will give a strong delusion to those who will not accept the truth (see 2 Thessalonians 2:10). There can come a point when someone has resisted God's truth and ignored His voice so much that God finally says, "Enough," and takes their conscience away. Scripture refers to these people as those who have had their "*conscience seared with a hot iron*" (1 Timothy 4:2). If you have ever been burned so severely that it left a scar, you will have noticed that the scar is less sensitive than the rest of your skin because the burn has desensitized that area of your body. In the same way, you can harden your heart to the Lord to the point where your conscience becomes seared and is no longer sensitive to the Lord. This means that you can now easily do things that at one time would have grieved you and caused you to lose your peace. If you continually harden your heart against God's pricking of your conscience, there will come a time when you will no longer feel His conviction at all.

*“To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.” (Titus 1:15-16)*

This passage describes many of the people we met as we went door-to-door to talk about Jesus. Many professed to know God, but in works they denied Him. Please understand that I'm not talking about those who struggle, fall, and seek forgiveness. No one is sin-free. I am talking about those who sin and never humble themselves to God. Reprobation occurs to those who justify and rationalize their sin so that they don't have to repent. When a person does this long enough, they will become deceived and believe that they are going to get into Heaven regardless of how they live their lives.

### **Jesus Told Us How to Know if Someone is Truly Saved**

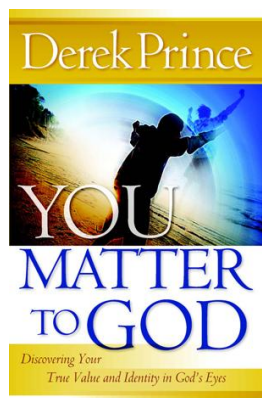
*“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it. Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you will know them.” (Matthew 7:13-20)*

Jesus is referring to the “fruits of the Spirit” described by Paul in Galatians, “*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.*” (Galatians 5:22-24) To know who really loves Jesus comes down simply to seeing whether there is fruit in their lives. Anyone can seem like they love Jesus or have a “form of godliness.” The Bible tells us that there are many wolves in sheep’s clothes. The only way you can truly test a person’s character is to be around them over a period of time in the context of the body of Christ. That way, you see not only how they relate to you, but how they relate to others as well. The fruit of their lives, or lack thereof, can then be truly evidenced.

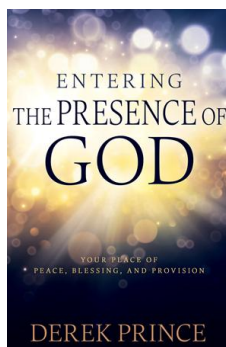
What is clear from looking at the life of Saul is that we are not to be fooled by a person’s words just because they may sound “spiritual.” 1 Samuel 2:3 says, “*Talk no more so very proudly; Let no arrogance come from your mouth. For the Lord is the God of knowledge; And by Him actions are weighed.*” We must always look at the fruit of a person’s life to see whether or not his actions match what he says.
